




Definitions

"Incomplete Provider"



"Performance Metric Designation"

Provider Performance Rating Scale

Excellent 61+ points

Above Expectations 46-60 points

Meets Expectations 28-45 points

Below Expectations 16-27 points

Unsatisfactory 15 points or less

"VPK Staff Member"

A PreK Director and PreK Instructor as defined by s.1002.51(5) and (6), F.S.

"Prekindergarten director" means an onsite person ultimately responsible for the overall operation of a private prekindergarten provider or, alternatively, of the provider's prekindergarten program, regardless of whether the person is the owner of the provider.

"Prekindergarten instructor" means a teacher or child care personnel as defined in s. 402.302 who provide instruction to students in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program.

"Child care personnel" means all owners, operators, employees, and volunteers working in a child care facility.





VPK Education Improvement Plan

Plan Breakdown

Curriculum

- Select + Implement Approved Curriculum*
- Provide evidence of staff curriculum training

Staff Development

- Develop a plan
- Use approved staff development activities*

Communication

 Plan to notify families in writing of designation and improvement plan within 14 days of Coalition-approved plan, or child's enrollment

Submission Process

What's next?



Submission to Approval

- Annual
- 3 Forms
 - Curriculum
 - Staff Development
 - Communication
- Submission process forthcoming on DOE website
- Must be received within 30 calendar days of the earliest VPK start date @ provider
- Coalition reviews within 30 days of receipt:
 - All requirements-> approval
 - Missing requirements-> update provider status to "pending," return to provider with required revisions, ELC will offer assistance
 - Resubmit within 14 days of return



Failure to Submit

Failure to submit plan or revised plan within timeframes will result in:

Corrective Action Plan

Failure to implement CAP is grounds for **termination** of VPK contract

Implementation

- Submit evidence of implementation with DOE forms
- Must submit within timeframes (TBD)
- Failure to submit evidence results in a CAP
- Failure to adhere to CAP is grounds for termination

Incomplete Provider

A VPK provider without sufficient data to be assigned a performance metric designation

Incomplete Provider Requirements



Complete **Technical Assistance Plan for Incomplete Providers** (from DOE)

- Identifies causes
- Strategies to address causes
- Submission and Approval process is the same

Good Cause Exemption

After 3 consecutive years of Below Expectations, Unsatisfactory or a combination, provider must apply for Good Cause Exemption to continue VPK services.

Class I or multiple Class II violations within 2 years = ineligibility



Good Cause Exemption Required Data

Must document improvement for at least 2 of the following components:

- STAR achievement
- STAR learning gains
- Documented progress towards goals in IEP
- Improvement in Composite Score
- Evidence from ELC, District, DCF or LLA demonstrating compliance with health and safety during most recent program year
- Coalition certification of provider compliance with VPK deliverables during most recent program year
