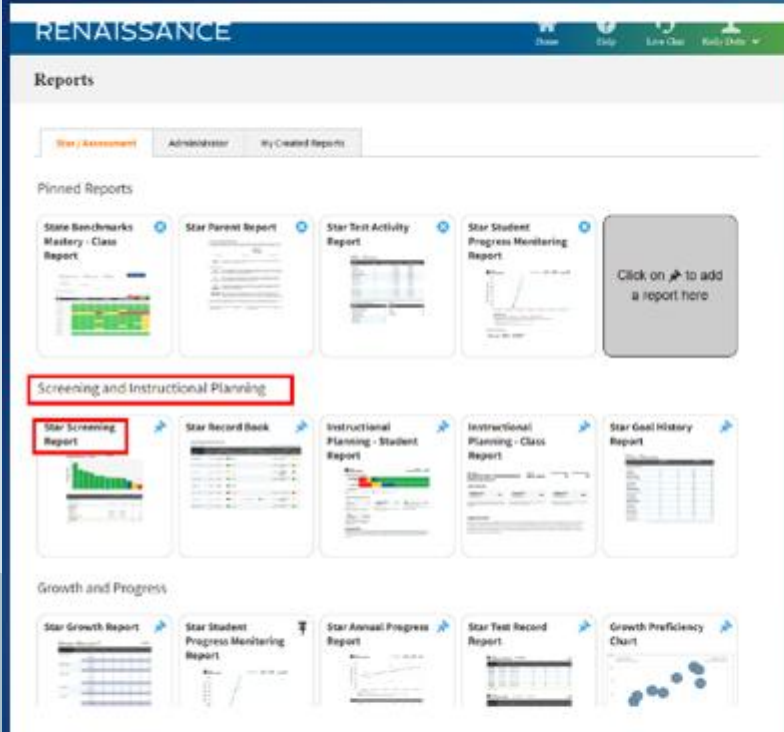

STAR EARLY LITERACY PM 2 REMINDERS

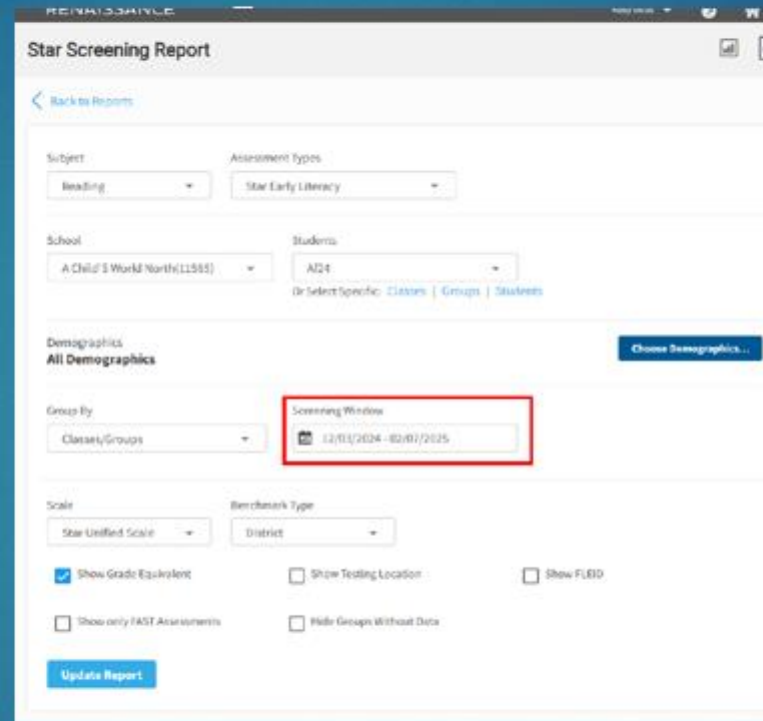
- While in ratio, best practice is:
 - Take child to quiet room (limit distractions)
 - Skip headphones so child and teacher can hear instructions
 - Only guidance may be provided (pay attention, listen, click the bunny, wait for the bunny, etc.) NOT related to the question
- Parent Letter **MUST** be physically sent home within 7 days of testing date (different for every child). This letter CAN be printed in Spanish.
- **Window dates are critical!**

- Inform communities about child care and the cost of care.
- Offer customized child care listings to families based on their needs.
- Provide a FREE marketing tool for ALL legally operating child care providers in Florida.



To complete your 2026 provider profile update and be included in child care listings to families:

1. Log on to your Provider Portal account.
2. Choose year 2026 on the top right hand side.
3. Click each tab and review the information. Make any necessary updates and verify accuracy of information.
4. Submit your profile for coalition review.
5. Periodically check for correspondence and the coalition's approval.

•A 5-year ban from contracting with ELCs for providers or their leadership convicted of public assistance fraud.

What Constitutes Fraud

Repeated non-compliance after TA

Knowingly reporting inaccurate attendance or data

Failure to correct documented issues

Patterns of inaccurate reporting

Pros of Compliance

Protects providers from fraud investigations

Ensures continued eligibility for federal and state funding

Builds trust with families and the Coalition

Reduces audit findings and corrective actions

Demonstrates accountability and program integrity

Why Diligence Matters

Although compliance requirements may feel cumbersome, accuracy and fidelity are essential.

Federal oversight is increasing, and even

unintentional errors can lead to funding

recoupment, sanctions, or legal consequences.

Provider Fraud Prevention Federal Early Learning Funds Under Scrutiny:



Federal Early Learning (ELC) dollars are currently under increased scrutiny. The Coalition is responsible for ensuring that federal and state funds are distributed appropriately and in compliance with all regulations.

Provider Responsibilities: Providers must be diligent in:

Maintaining accurate and complete records

Ensuring **SISO data matches attendance records**

Verifying daily attendance accuracy

Correcting errors promptly

Following guidance provided through Technical Assistance (TA)

Repeated inaccuracies, especially after Technical Assistance has been provided, may be reported and processed as **fraud**.
