Kindergarten Registration For the 2019-2020 School Year

The Okeechobee County School Board will be holding Kindergarten registration at the following schools:

May 21, Central Elementary School	462-5077
May 22, Everglades Elementary School	462-5108
May 23, South Elementary School	462-5087
May 24, Seminole Elementary School	462-5116
May 28, North Elementary School	462-5100

If your child will be 5-years-old on or before September 1, 2019, you should begin gathering the following information required by law to enter public school:

Legal Proof of Birth Date

Up-to-Date Immunization Record

Health Exam Record that has been completed by a physician since September 1, 2018.

Proof of Residence (FPL statement; OUA statement, etc.)

Please contact the school your child will attend to schedule an appointment for kindergarten registration. If you do not know which school your child should attend, contact the Student Services Office at 462-5000 extension 260.








National Read Across America Day (Dr. Seuss Day) is celebrated on March 2nd, the birthday of Dr. Seuss.

VPK Registration


All VPK registration must be done on the Family Portal @

If you need assistance, staff is available in each of our offices to assist you. Each of the offices is equipped with a kiosk where you can apply online and upload your documents.

The program is free for 4-year-olds who reside in Florida and were born on or before Sept. 1 of the year they would enter the program. Parents of 4-year-olds with birthdays from Feb. 2 through Sept. 1 may postpone enrolling their child until the following year when they are 5.
